However, The grades required for courses are **ACTUAL** grades, not projected so it is important to note that student offers will be **Conditional** depending upon results in summer 2016.

Please note: for the purpose of counting Level 2 qualifications each subject counts as one result only eg. a Pass/Merit/Distinction in a BTEC level 2 subject counts as **one Grade C equivalent**. Many subjects have individual entry requirements in addition to those shown above, these can be found on the following pages.

Non qualification hours are additional hours you will carry out which develop your employability skills. We aim to run all courses offered but this may not be possible if demand is low. Option blocks will be created and published following student interviews in order to cater for as many individual choices of subject combinations as possible.
