Impact 2017	
Subject	Outcome (Year 7)
English	<p>Based on Teacher Assessment, pupils eligible for Year 7 Catch Up made an Average Points Score progress of +0.38 compared to 0.87 for all Year 7 pupils.</p> <p>The provision for Year 7 Catch Up in English will be adjusted in 2017/18 in order to improve the impact of the Cath-Up funding in English.</p>
Maths	Based on Teacher Assessment, pupils eligible for Year 7 Catch Up made an Average Points Score progress of +1.25 compared to all 2.09 for all pupils.
SEND	SEND pupils made on average (across all subjects) more progress (0.82 Average Point Score more) than non-SEND pupils.
