**YEAR 6 VISITS TO BALBY CARR COMMUNITY ACADEMY**  
**Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2015**

As part of our transition programme your child has been invited to visit Balby Carr Academy for the day, in preparation for their forthcoming move to Secondary School. The visit will enable them to meet staff and pupils and become more familiar with the school and its structures.

Children will be able to experience a typical day at Balby Carr. They will have the fantastic opportunity to be involved in a variety of subjects, meet new friends and some of the teachers who will be supporting their learning next year. The focus will be to make the day active and enjoyable, giving pupils the opportunity to sample some of our excellent learning opportunities and outstanding facilities.

On Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July, you need to ensure your child can make their way safely to Balby Carr for 8.45am, entering the school via the main gates on Weston Road, this is in preparation for September.

They will be greeted by Academy staff who will direct them to the Sports Hall where they will be met and registered by their primary teacher. We encourage your child to sample our excellent catering facilities on the day and they will need to bring £2.00 to cover the cost of lunch should they wish to do so. Alternatively students can bring a packed lunch. Free school meals will be provided for those students who normally receive them. Students will also be taking part in a PE session so may wish to bring appropriate footwear.

Please ensure arrangements have been made for your child to get home safely, they will be dismissed from the Academy at 2:30pm via the main gates on Weston Road.

We recognise that this is an important day in our calendar and we are looking forward to your child coming to enjoy the day with us.

Can you please complete the medical form overleaf and give them to your child's Y6 teacher before the 7<sup>th</sup> July. Students will not be allowed to remain on site if we do not have this important information.

We would also like to invite all Y6 parents and students to an information meeting at 6pm on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July lasting for approximately 1 hour.
